What's New in Version 5.1

This release fixes several issues discovered since the release of version 5.0. The full list of changes and fixes in this version are listed below.

Important: If using Outlook 2013 on the migration workers the Microsoft update patch KB2878323 is required for Outlook Professional Plus 2013 SP1.

Release Notes 5.1

- An issue where corrupt response document tables for calendar items were causing the migration to terminate abnormally has been resolved. (59754)
- The Notes mail field "Categories" can now be migrated to Exchange. (57586)
- The btmil.box recreate limit has been removed. Each time the MIME processing encounters an error, the btmil.box will be recreated and the migration will continue without aborting. (59036)
- The Notes Migrator Controller and Worker installers were updated to include the latest timezonetextfile.txt file. New time zones were added to this file to accommodate certain mobile devices that were not previously included. (58697)
- Settings option added for Notes-specific items in the body of a message to be encapsulated in an attached NSF. These items can then be acted upon post-migration by linking back to Notes (59169)
- A two-part matching process has been implemented to prevent PowerShell from crashing when running a Name Translation Match with more than 5,000 objects. (60070)
- A statement about using the target Active Directory displayName attribute when translating messages has been removed from the user guide. This functionality was removed in version 4.6.2. (60651)
- An issue where migration profiles disappear and cannot be assigned to users when chosen has been fixed. (60087)
- An issue where recipients were being duplicated on encrypted documents has been fixed. (60639)
- An enhancement to include the Sametime meeting URL in the meeting body was implemented (60831).
- An issue where Delegation Notices failed to migrate to non-system folders has been fixed. The log reporting the "Destination is NULL" has been elevated to an error. (60229)
- "NoteID:xxxx" text was moved to the first position of the Comment column. The "NoteID: xxxx" text is populated only when the document cannot be opened. (60227)
- An invalid document error emanating from the calendar query has been resolved. Defensive code was added to handle the Notes error during the calendar document query collection. (59932)
- An issue causing a warning message to be displayed when migrating messages containing more than one attachment has been fixed. Retry routines were added to the Exchange document properties to reprocess the attachments. (59389)
- An issue causing incorrect MIME translation has been fixed. Attachment MIME handling was removed during the Outlook API processing for attachments processed outside the MIMEStream. (59788)
- An issue causing missing log entries in the UNID CSV audit file has been fixed. This issue occurred for documents that were skipped when stored in multiple folders. To resolve the issue, CSV lines were added for every instance of a document that was already migrated and stored in additional folders. (59778)

- Recipients were not migrating to PSTs on some meetings. This issue was fixed by adding defensive code to handle the lookup during PST migrations for recipients. (59905)
- An issue where message header information was appearing in the migrated email body has been fixed. (59915)
- An issue causing a crash when recovering from an 80040109 warning after rewriting the recipients has been fixed. (58915)
- To improve data migration validation, two additional .csv log files are now being generated. These logs report the UNID and migration result of each processed document. (59316)
- An issue where messages over 90 MB caused the migration process to fail due to a memory error has been resolved. (58916)
- An issue with (546) Notes Item Not Found errors when processing large attachments has been corrected. (59217)

- An issue where the Room & Resource form didn't show the "Shortname" unless "Enable BPOS Features" was set has been resolved. (16593)
- An issue where there was a double space between the first name and last name in migrated contacts has been resolved. (16668)
- An issue where Japanese character category names in Notes appeared as "?????" in Outlook has been resolved. (26557)
- An issue where the decryption button in did not set the decryptedByBT field has been resolved. (33606)
- Changes have been made to support Office 365 region-specific data centers. (33651)
- Responses to the Archive Migrator Opt Out option can now be seen in a new Archive Migrator Responses view added to the left navigation. (39968)
- An issue where the Local Archive Discovery did not add the sent message notification if the Archive Migrator email was sent prior to migration of the account has been resolved. (40385)
- Migration log details have been added to the Rooms and Resources documents. (40421)
- The ability to migrate Discussion databases has been removed. (42953)
- PowerShell 5.0 is now supported for Access and Delegation Migration. (43457)
- Migrations will now be aborted if the Outlook Mime bodies cannot be migrated. (45065)
- An issue causing an error when the junk folder had to be created for a migration has been resolved. (45745)
- An issue where the Office 365 activation agent would hang after selecting a license type has been resolved. (45850)
- An issue where the service did not stop for several minutes when exiting the worker from the system tray has been resolved. The "Exit Now" and "Finish and Exit" commands are now working as expected. (46935)
- A new method for determining migration history has been added. The new Discover History from Migrated Data option scans the migrated data (mailbox, archives, etc.) to find messages previously migrated to Notes. The previous method is available as Classic - NotelD option. (47276)
- The Remove Migrated function now removes Previous Migration Record (Kilroy) documents and Skipped/Problem Document records. (47504)
- Calendar notices found only in the All Documents view are no longer migrated to "Unfiled". Notices in the

Inbox or in a folder are migrated. (48795)

- A migration workstation will now be taken offline if the workstation fails to start three consecutive migrations with the same status error so an administrator can address the issue. On the CMT Monitor screen, the workstation will have a status of "Needs Attention". (48843)
- The migration status list has been updated with the following statuses:
 - Nothing in Source File – The source mailfile is able to open but does not contain any data.
 - Source Database Not Initialized – The source mailfile fails to open with "Database Not Initialized".
 - AutoDiscover Failure – The Target mailbox fails to connect with Autodiscover.

- The RetryJobStatus parameter has been added to the web.config file to support automatically resubmitting failed jobs. By default, Notes Migrator will resubmit memory exception codes #001 (Notes memory exception) and #002 (Outlook memory exception). (48845)
- The Notes Migrator database UNID is now used as the key for the SQL migration record instead of the Shortname value where duplicates are found. (48846)
- An issue where the fix contacts agent incorrectly removed local group members when multiple address books are configured on the Settings document has been resolved. (49029)
- To allow rooms with long values in the "Resource Target File Name" field to be imported, the Import Rooms & Resources agent has been updated to use the shortname and not the full resource name as the file path for the extract nsf. (49274)
- An issue where Autodiscover would fail in hybrid environments if the target account has an online archive enabled has been resolved. (49322)
- An issue causing scheduled delegation to not process and not export a text file has been resolved. (49418)
- An issue causing a memory exception error "Error encountered Getting Body" has been resolved. (49465)
- Notes Archive Migrator has been updated to version 2.5.1. Version 2.5.1 adds support for archiving French mail templates. (49562)
- An issue where the BTMail.box was becoming corrupt which resulted in migrations transferring attachments as a file type image has been resolved. Now, the BTMail.box MIME cache is deleted and recreated if a specific error is encountered when converting a message body, which indicates the cache has become corrupt. If the cache becomes corrupt twice during the same migration, the migration will exit with the status "Migration Failed". (49924)
- The PR_RECIPIENT_REASSIGNMENT_PROHIBITED setting is now properly set based on the Prevent Delegation value on appointments and notices. (50007)
- Outlook 2010 has been removed from the requirements. (51607)
- An issue where room and resource imports and migrations did not support a slash (/) in the name has been resolved. (52373)
- A code change has been made to speed up the processing of repeating meetings to Office 365. (53263)
- An issue where Name Translation was failing intermittently for a user that was previously successfully converted has been resolved. (53763)
- The Process attachments greater than option in Advanced Settings is set to 5 MB by default. (54112)
